### TURNOVER INDICES FOR THE SERVICES SECTOR - Fourth quarter 2011

The evolution of the Turnover Indices for the Services Sector with base year 2005=100.0 for the fourth quarter of 2011, according to the provisional and working day adjusted data on the specific activities of services, has as follows:

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Specifically, the evolution of the compiled Turnover Indices for the Services Sector is illustrated in the following tables. The data are provisional when first released and become final in the next quarter.

Table 1 represents the annual rates of change of the above – mentioned indices of the fourth quarter of 2011, compared with the fourth quarter of 2010, as well as the annual rates of change of the fourth quarter of 2010 compared with the fourth quarter 2009.

Table 2 represents the quarterly rates of change of the above – mentioned indices of the fourth quarter of 2011, compared with the third quarter of 2011, as well as the quarterly rates of change of the fourth quarter of 2010 compared with the third quarter 2010.

Table 3 represents the evolution of the above – mentioned indices per quarter for the period 2007 – 2011.

## Methodological notes

<b>General</b>	The Turnover Indices in the Services Sector are quarterly indices that were published for the first time in Greece in 2006 with base year 2005=100.0. The initial compilation of the mentioned indices was done according to the old classification NACE Rev.1 and covered the period 2005-2008. In 2009 it was implemented the current compilation of indices in accordance with the new classification NACE Rev.2.
<b>Purpose of the Indices-definitions</b>	<p>The Services Turnover Indices are business cycle indicators, which illustrate the quarterly activity of the services sectors (other than retail trade) in value.</p> <p>Turnover comprises the totals invoiced by the observation unit during the reference period and this corresponds to market sales of goods or services supplied to third parties. Turnover also includes all the other charges (transport., packaging, etc.) passed on to the customer, even if these charges are listed separately in the invoice.</p> <p>Turnover excludes VAT and other similar deductible taxes directly linked to turnover as well as all duties and taxes on the goods or services invoiced by the unit.</p>
<b>Legal basis</b>	The turnover indices in the services sector are new indices, with base year 2005=100.0 covering the period from 2005 onwards. The compilation and publication of these new indices is based upon the requirements of the Council Regulation (EC) No 1165/98 concerning short-term statistics as well as the amendment Regulation No1158/2005 of the European Parliament and Council amending the Council Regulation (EC) No 1165/98.
<b>Reference period</b>	Quarterly
<b>Base year</b>	2005=100.0
<b>Revision</b>	The revision of the Services Turnover Indices is done in the framework of implementation of the Council Regulation No 1165/98, in which it is foreseen that the short-term indices are revised each 5 years, with base year ending in 0 or 5.
<b>Statistical Classification</b>	It is used the Eurostat NACE Rev.2 classification of economic activities (Regulation 1893/2006 of the European Parliament and Council)

<b>Statistical survey</b>	<p>The survey for the compilation of the new Turnover Indices in the services sector for the abovementioned divisions of the NACE Rev. 2 statistical classification included a total of 2,535 enterprises providing services in these divisions with an annual turnover equal to or higher than 600,000 Euros, according to the Business Register of the Ministry of Economy and Finance for the year 2005.</p> <p>A representative sample of 394 enterprises from all parts of the country was selected. The method used to select the enterprises for inclusion in the sample to be surveyed was that of single-stage stratified random sampling. In each of the said two-digit divisions of economic activity the enterprises covered by the survey were stratified in six turnover brackets according to the magnitude of their annual turnover in 2005.</p>
<b>Compilation of indices</b>	The compilation of indices is done by applying the method of chaining, while it is applied the adjustment of indices in typical quarter by multiplying the estimated turnover values with an adjustment factor in accordance with the working days of each quarter. The typical quarter refers to the real number of working days.
<b>Publication of data</b>	The data of the new Turnover Indices for the Services Sector with base year 2005=100.0 are published from the first quarter 2009, while back data are available from the first quarter 2000.
